




ACTIVITIES OF CSR COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR 2020-21

(iii) Flyers issued to educate public at large regarding precautions to be taken for restart of operations post lockdown.




(iv) Video released regarding precautions to be taken for restart of operations post lockdown.




(v) Appreciation certificates were issued to more than 1,000 members who contributed to the welfare of the society during the pandemic.
